CAMP AT THE SUFFOLK COUNTY FARM!

Get ready to embark on an epic adventure this summer at the Suffolk County Farm and Education Center. Have you ever wanted to ride a horse, learn how to make old-fashioned ice cream or explore a Butterfly House? One of the most unique experiences on Long Island, campers' grades K-8 will take part in hands on activities in animal science, agriculture, and environmental science lead by experienced and trained educators. Imagine a day complete with nature crafts, wagon rides, tasting fresh produce, sprinklers, llama hikes, and bug collecting. Hours will be filled with new experiences that you cannot find anywhere else but a century old working farm. Make new friends while trekking from the Greenhouse to our brand new Nature Explore Classroom and build self-confidence with every step from the cornfields to the Cow Barn. You might have so much fun that you want to stay for the whole summer! Campers do not have to worry about doing the same things twice, educators will always be changing their activities and building on their education throughout the summer. Don't miss this chance to be a real farmer, veterinarian and a naturalist all at the same camp!

DOG DAYS - Speciality program for week 6 Navigators.

Share your camp experience with your dog! You will have the chance to bring your dog with you for 2 of the scheduled days for fun and socialization. Camp activities may include demonstrations by local obedience and agility trainers, hiking and scavenger hunts with the dogs, first-aid training, and making homemade dog treats. Dogs must be well behaved with no aggression issues, must know basic obedience commands and be comfortable on a leash and in a crate, must be at least 6 months old, and have proof of rabies vaccination. Dogs in season will not be permitted. Participants are responsible for bringing water and food dish, food, treats, collar, leash, and crate and are responsible for cleaning up after dogs at all times. Only one dog per camper, but a dog is not needed to attend.

FARM ANIMAL CARE IOI - Speciality Camp for High School Students Grades 9-12: July 2, 3, 5, 6

This technical camp offers teens a one-of-a-kind opportunity to explore their interest in working with animals. Our skilled educators take a hands-on approach, guaranteeing participants a unique learning experience which includes daily feeding and maintenance of animals, grooming and handling, training young animals, milking dairy animals, piglet care, studying embryology, and more. Participants will have a chance to work with all of our livestock- horses, llamas, cattle, sheep, goats, pigs, poultry, and rabbits- and are certain to have a memorable and unique week in a safe and fun environment.

- All camps run from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm. Before & After Care options from 7:00 am - 6:00 pm. See chart on next page.
- Register now by mail. Telephone registration begins April 30th with VISA or MasterCard. Call 852-4600 Mon – Fri, 11am - 2pm only!
- Full payment is due at time of registration.
- Confirmation of your registration will be mailed to you along with a Medical and Acknowledgement of Risk form which MUST be completed and returned at least two weeks before camp starts or registration will be cancelled.
- Your registration signifies acceptance of, and agreement to, all Registration Information policies and procedures.
- You may cancel your registration in writing up to two weeks prior to your program start date. You will be refunded 70% of the pre-paid program fee. No refund will be made if cancellation is received less than two weeks prior to start date (determined by envelope postmark date). Cornell Cooperative Extension reserves the right to cancel any camp program for any reason, in which case a full refund of the pre-paid program fee will be issued.
- Children dismissed or absent from camp will not be entitled to a refund, credit, or exchange of dates.
- Any change in camp sessions/dates will incur a \$20.00 administrative fee. No changes permitted after June 30th.
- Transportation to and from camp is not provided. Parents/guardians are required to accompany their child from the parking field to camp to check-in and check-out each day.
- All campers are responsible for bringing their own lunch, snack, and beverage. Refrigeration is provided.
- All 4-H operated camp programs are licensed and inspected yearly by the Suffolk County Department of Health.
