Course applicants must be **interviewed** as part of acceptance consideration. In addition, Cornell requires a successful **background check** for training admission. Please understand these efforts take additional time.

No fees should be submitted now.

(Course fees of \$550...\$425 course fee plus \$125 refundable deposit if 125 volunteer hours are met within the first two years of course completion... are due after an interview and successful background check.)

Ongoing health considerations will be monitored for class gatherings. We will meet in person for some course content, field trips, workshops and other activities. Please note that Master Gardener Training relies primarily on an electronic 'classroom' for accessing course lectures and resources. Although not required, previous online learning will be an asset.
