# PECONIC DUNES 4-H CAMP CANCELLATION AND REFUND POLICY

## Deposit is non-refundable.

\$160 deposit per session required for overnight camp, \$95 deposit per session required for day camp, \$550 deposit for CIT program

## After May 1, 2022

\$50 cancellation fee per overnight session. \$25 cancellation fee per day camp session. All other monies, minus deposit and cancellation fee, will be returned.

#### After June 1, 2022

\$100 cancellation fee per overnight session. \$50 cancellation fee per day camp session. All other monies, minus deposit and cancellation fee, will be returned. \$250 cancellation fee for CITs if received at least **three weeks** prior to the start of the registered program.

## After June 26, 2022 (Camp starts.)

\$200 cancellation fee per overnight session. \$100 cancellation fee per day camp session. All other monies, minus deposit and cancellation fee, will be returned.

## In the event of camper illness

Peconic Dunes 4-H Camp will not admit any camper who shows signs of illness, including a temperature of 100.4°F or above. He/she may return to camp when they are well and have proof of a negative COVID-19 test. If the overnight camper is not well enough to return to camp or tests positive, the camp will issue a full refund of deposit and payments for that session minus a \$50 cancellation fee. In the event, an overnight camper becomes ill at camp, he/she will be sent home and the camp will issue a prorated refund for the days remaining in the session. Day campers who are ill for two or more consecutive days in week will receive a prorated refund for those days.

#### Note

In the event that Cornell Cooperative Extension of Suffolk County, based on guidance from Cornell University and/or New York State, cancels any or all camp sessions, families will receive a refund of all deposits and payments minus a \$25 administrative fee to cover our costs for these transactions.

# No refunds

If a camper is sent home for behavioral reasons including but not limited to: violating camp rules and policies (see Parent Handbook), homesickness, non-compliance, failure to thrive (e.g., not eating, sleeping or participating), there will be no refund. A camper who does not arrive, arrives late, leaves early, or attends only part of the session will not receive a refund.

#### Important note about homesickness

Camp staff make every effort to help campers who struggle with separation from home. If a camper is still homesick and unwilling to adjust to camp life, the parent will be asked to take the child home from camp, in which case, there will be no refund or credit.
