Narcan, also known as naloxone, is a medication used to reverse opioid overdoses. Now more than ever, individuals are encouraged to prepare themselves with the training and confidence they need to respond quickly in an overdose situation. NARCAN workshops equip individuals with the knowledge and skills needed to respond effectively in an opioid overdose emergency.

This program provides information on how to recognize an opioid overdose, administer naloxone, and care for the individual until emergency services arrive. Individuals who complete the training program will receive a naloxone (Narcan) kit.
