The Joy of Gardening is an online course offered by Cornell Cooperative Extension of Suffolk County.

As the 10-week course is self-paced with weekly guidelines, students explore materials on their own schedule.

The course instructor, Roxanne Zimmer, has been teaching for many years. In addition, Master Gardeners will serve as teaching assistants assigned to individual course participants. The Master Gardeners can answer your questions regarding course material and access to them.

Most materials are readable, clickable or downloads in pdf or video file formats. Familiarity with online learning is a plus, not a requirement. Although smart phones will work, a desktop or laptop or tablet computer device will likely provide better audio and video resonance as well as compatibility with file sizes.
